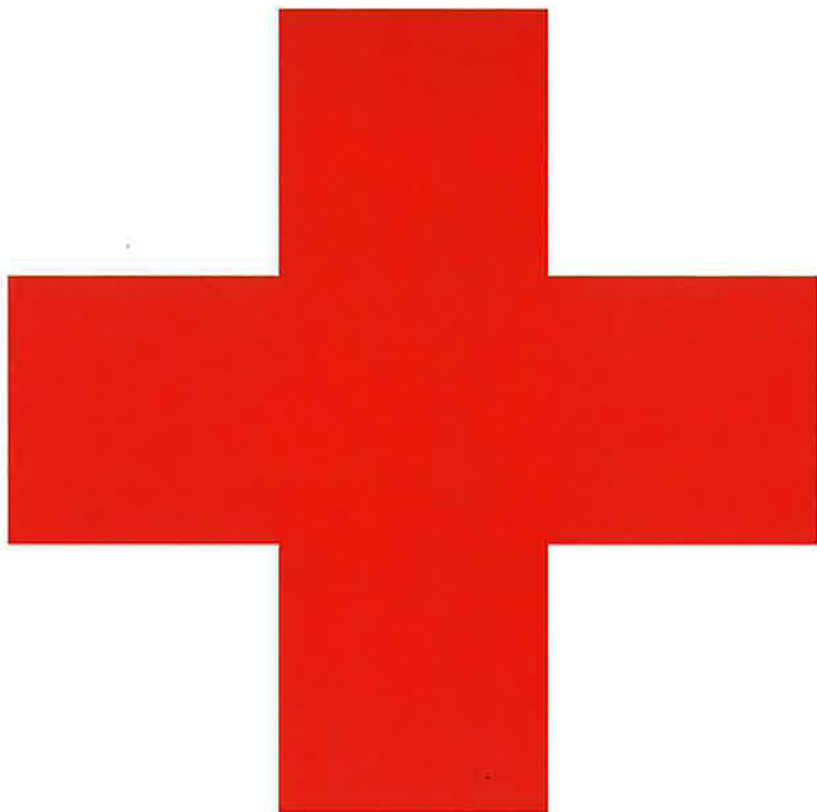

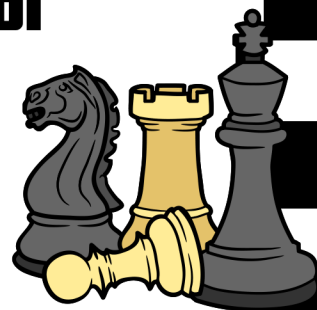

Water Safety Instructor Blended Learning – Certification Class
Ages 16 – Adult

Overview of Class:

Participants learn skills and knowledge to teach children and adults to be safe in, on and around water. (plus other areas: swim strokes, practice teaching, how to write a lesson & block plan)

Participants must be able to:

- Swim 25 yards of – Front Crawl, Back Crawl, Breaststroke, Elementary backstroke, Side Stroke and Butterfly (Level 4 Stroke Performance).
- Maintain position on back for 1 min in deep water (floating or sculling).
- Tread water for 1 minute.
- Fundamentals of Instructor Training Course (FIT) Included in WSI course hours.

Upon Successful Completion:

- Participants receive a certificate for the American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor (also, FIT Certificate) and qualify to apply for WSI positions.
- Participants must attend all classes, no exceptions. Limited to 6 students.
- Bring swim gear, (NO bikini suits) towels, 3 ring binder, pen, highlighter and lunch on every day. (You will be in and out of the pool, so any extra dry suit & extra towels are helpful)
- Student Must Attend all Classes
