Sacred Heart Building. The Abatement for Asbestos quote was received. Duininck's is taking another look at potential demolition costs.

Pool. Supt. Froke spoke to US Aquatics about operating levies and bond referendums for school pools. The numbers reviewed at the last Board meeting were hypothetical numbers to show potential impact and were not exact annual operational costs. If we were to build a new pool, those numbers would be communicated. The Board would like to meet with US Aquatics as well.

Jaguar Jamboree. The District will send out a survey to determine we there is enough interest to hold Jaguar Jamboree again next school year.

Graduation. The goal is to run graduation as typical as possible. Plans are being made in case harsher restrictions are enforced at that time.
